

Protecting Yourself This Flu Season

etting the flu is no fun. It can cause fever, body Jaches, headache, and a pesky cough. These uncomfortable symptoms typically last a week or two, and the virus is highly contagious. Because these symptoms may not start for a couple of days, you may pass the flu to someone before you know you have it.

Clifford Quan, MD, chief of infectious diseases for the Kaiser Permanente Diablo Service Area, which includes the Antioch and Walnut Creek medical centers, said flu is expected to circulate widely this fall and winter, and urges people to get vaccinated.

"Vaccination remains the best protection against severe illness, hospitalization, and death from the flu virus," Quan said.

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that everyone 6 months old



and older get a flu vaccine. Getting a flu shot also protects those around you who may be at higher risk for flu complications. That includes children 5 and younger, adults 65 and older, pregnant people, and people with chronic conditions such as asthma, diabetes, heart disease, cancer and HIV. With other illnesses possibly circulating, it's especially important to stay safe and prevent the flu.

"The best way to protect yourself, your family, and our communities is to get vaccinated," Quan said. "Flu viruses change each year, and the immunity you get from the shot may fade, so it's important to get vaccinated each year.

Flu is usually caused by the influenza viruses types A and B. There

are different subtypes, or strains, of the flu virus every year. New flu vaccines are created every year to fight the latest virus strain.

"In addition to getting vaccinated, washing your hands often and staying home when sick is the best way to protect yourself and to keep the virus from spreading to others," he said.

Most people can treat flu symptoms at home with rest, medicines, or other treatment. Some people at higher risk or with severe symptoms may need treatment in the hospital.

Throughout the flu season, Kaiser Permanente members can get a flu shot at no additional cost during any doctor visit or at one of our flu shot locations.






