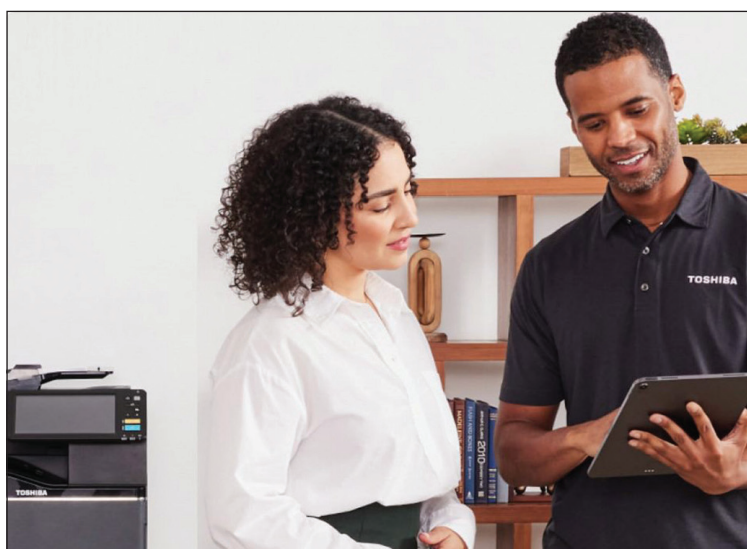

Built with Love: The Story Behind Fusion Wine Bar

Tammy has been doing nails in this community for 30 years. She knows her clients by name, remembers their kids, and jokes around while she works. So when she finally opened a restaurant this past April, nobody who knows her was surprised that it feels exactly like that — warm, personal, a little fun.

Fusion Wine Bar is tucked into Suite 220 at 3030 Bernal Ave. The menu is Vietnamese fusion — think familiar flavors with a creative twist — paired with local wines, beers, and mocktails. Tammy wanted it to feel less like a restaurant and more like coming over for dinner. "We do everything with love," she says. Her staff, she'll tell you, aren't employees. They're family.

In Vietnamese culture, bars have traditionally been owned by men or run by tight-knit crews — women rarely open them. Tammy

is the first in her generation and among her elders to run a bar. It's not easy to build a business, but she'll be the first to say she's lucky: great staff, a family vibe, and a community that shows up.

That support makes her stronger.

The idea for Fusion rattled around for nine years. She kept putting it off, staying focused on the salon. But the urge to do something more for the community never went



away. Tammy came to this country with nothing and built two businesses from the ground up. The way she sees it, she owes America one.

"This country carried me to success," she says. "I don't mind working hard. I just want a chance to give back."

That shows up on the menu in a real way. First responders get 15% off, no questions asked. Down the road, she's hoping to add discounts for teachers, nurses, and doctors too — once business picks up a little more.

Ask her what she loves most about running a business and she doesn't mention revenue or foot traffic. "Seeing people smile," she says. "I love to see people happy." She's been at this long enough that her reputation speaks for itself. "The people remember me as an honest person. Everything is quality." Then she laughs. "And I like to joke."

She also has something she wants younger people to hear. Not a lecture — just something she means. "I hope they know how lucky they are to live here. Don't take it for granted." It lands differently coming from someone who's lived it.

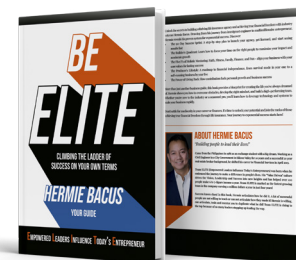

Dr. Mary Manning didn't plan a career change — she was simply looking for pain relief.

While working as a Registered Veterinary Technician in North Carolina, she injured her back restoring her first home. After six months of persistent pain and limited success with conventional treatments, she tried acupuncture. For the first time in months, she experienced a full day without pain. Continued treatments also brought improvements in digestion, anxiety, and sleep.

That personal transformation sparked a new calling. Around the same time, a veterinarian colleague was studying veterinary acupuncture at Chi University. Together they integrated acupuncture into patient care, often helping animals improve without surgery.
